Our starting place for this Bible lesson is Proverbs 8. Now that I have reached the senior years of my life, people ask me, “*how did you know who would be the best partner in your life?*”

In this Bible lesson, we will answer that question and other important life questions according to God’s principles and wisdom. Proverbs 8:1-11 *Doth not wisdom cry? and understanding put forth her voice? She standeth in the top of high places, by the way in the places of the paths. She crieth at the gates, at the entry of the city, at the coming in at the doors. Unto you, O men, I call; and my voice is to the sons of man. O ye simple, understand wisdom: and, ye fools, be ye of an understanding heart. Hear; for I will speak of excellent things; and the opening of my lips shall be right things. For my mouth shall speak truth; and wickedness is an abomination to my lips. All the words of my mouth are in righteousness; there is nothing froward or perverse in them. They are all plain to him that understandeth, and right to them that find knowledge. Receive my instruction, and not silver; and knowledge rather than choice gold. For wisdom is better than rubies; and all the things that may be desired are not to be compared to it.*

Everything in life requires wisdom. In order for us to succeed in any relationship, we will need to be wise. Intelligent people have marriages that fail. Brilliant people do a very poor job of raising children. Rich people, powerful people cannot maintain friendships. People that have studied their Bible and know it frontwards and backwards have trouble with staying in one church for any length of time.

The Lord says there is a relationship that you need to have with wisdom. It is essential. It is fundamental. It undergirds every other relationship in the home, work, or the church, and it must be acquired.

Wisdom is not hidden behind six years of seminary walls. Wisdom is not hidden behind the trappings of some remote place in a mountain top or in a faraway village where you lock yourself away from society and seek inner peace or deeper truth. Wisdom is crying out as you drive down the road. It is crying out as you walk down the sidewalk. It is calling out to you as you sit in your home. God is not hiding wisdom. God is not making wisdom a difficult thing to locate. God has made wisdom available to everyone who wants to have it. Praise the Lord.

Wisdom cries out and says, “*Are you without understanding? Are you simple? I can make you wise.*” God doesn’t limit the ability to be wise to those

who are naturally gifted or naturally able. Isn't that a wonderful thing? You might have grown up in a one parent family or have been taught everything wrong, yet wisdom calls out and says, *"Let me enter your life, and I can give you the wisdom of kings, the wisdom of the greatest men and women who have ever lived."* The most important first step in our lives is salvation and the second is wisdom. Both come from God, and we need both to live our lives so they are pleasing to our Lord. The Lord says if you had a choice between riches and wisdom, your best choice would be wisdom.

Our peace and contentment come from the wisdom found in the pages of the word of God. Education cannot equal contentment, money cannot equal joy or satisfaction in life. Only the wisdom that comes from the word of God can give you that. The Bible says in Psalm 119:105 *Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.* It will guide our steps and direct our way, making our lives full of absolute satisfaction and happiness as we walk in the ways of the Lord Jesus Christ, the Bible says in Proverbs 8:6-8 *Hear; for I will speak of excellent things; and the opening of my lips shall be right things. For my mouth shall speak truth; and wickedness is an abomination to my lips. All the words of my mouth are in righteousness; there is nothing froward or perverse in them.*, Our society has abandoned the Bible and rejected the existence of sin and ungodliness. It tells people to follow their heart, leading them to believe their life could be like a fairy tale. But forsaking the word of God often leads hearts bent toward stealing, murder, rioting, looting, and harming others.

Wisdom corrects and encourages. Wisdom discerns between truth and error. Wisdom shows us the right way to live. What a joy to have purpose and reason for living, without having to depend on an internet chat group or the news for help in making decisions in life.

Just go to the word of God and find out what is right. We know that every statement in the word of God is true and righteous altogether.

If God says something is a sin, we do not have to ask why. We just trust Him. If God says something will bless our life, we do not have to reason it or figure it out. Just trust Him, and it will prove itself every single time.

Most of our society has thrown away the word of God. They have thrown away common sense. They are indoctrinating children in things that ought not to be spoken of by anyone anywhere. If you must normalize something, it's not normal. If you must justify something, it is not just. Sadly, we live in a society that mocks and makes fun of the Bible, and look what they are offering as an alternative, smut, filthiness, commercials that show a woman's privates, hygiene remedies without shame. We live in a day when adultery and unfaithfulness is not even given a second thought. Someone can be considered a moral man, a righteous man, a God-fearing man with a string of wives and illegitimate children left in his wake. We need to start listening to

what the Bible says again. No error, no perverseness, no ungodliness is taught within its pages. The Bible will teach us how to live right. Every man, every woman would be better off if their spouse feared God and believed the Bible. Every child would be better off being raised by a father and mother who were God-fearing and believed the Bible.

Proverbs 8:12 *I wisdom dwell with prudence, and find out knowledge of witty inventions.* You should not need to dabble in sin or practice immorality. Immodesty is not pretty. Crudeness is not masculine. *I wisdom dwell with prudence, and find out knowledge of witty inventions.* God has already dealt with everything we will encounter in life. He already knows how we can be victorious in every situation. If our desire is to be victorious in life, we are to follow the advice of Proverbs 8:13 *The fear of the LORD is to hate evil: pride, and arrogancy, and the evil way, and the froward mouth, do I hate.*

You know why so many young people live like fools instead of wise people? Because they sit at the feet of arrogant entertainers. Everything about them shouts pride. The media builds them up. Pride, haughty, arrogant, defiant. Look at their communication - *"Nobody tames me. Look at me. Nobody tells me what to do. Look at me. I don't follow any rules. Look at me. I'm not governed by societal norms."* If we are looking at that, we will never be wise. We need to turn our eyes away from all that arrogant garbage and all that pride and humble ourselves. James 4:10 *Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up.* Nobody is stronger or greater or has accomplished more than Jesus Christ. Nobody is more amazing than Jesus Christ, and He humbled Himself. That is the way of wisdom, that is the path of righteousness. The Bible says in Proverbs 8:14 *Counsel is mine, and sound wisdom: I am understanding; I have strength.* You will never have time enough in your life to research, study and investigate all the aspects of life. You know what Lord said? *"Counsel is mine."* You want a counselor? *"Open the Bible."* You have a problem in your marriage? *"Open the Bible."* You have emotional difficulties? *"Open the Bible"* Are you looking for a mate? *"Open the Bible."* God has all the answers for everything in life and in death. He has the entire realm of existence covered. No psychiatrist will ever know what He knows. Do not waste your money.

The Bible says in Proverbs 8:21 *That I may cause those that love me to inherit substance; and I will fill their treasures.* When we view the verses below, How much more is the Lord capable of giving us?

Proverbs 8:22-30 *The LORD possessed me in the beginning of his way, before his works of old. I was set up from everlasting, from the beginning, or ever the earth was. When there were no depths, I was brought forth; when there were no fountains abounding with water. Before the mountains were settled, before the hills was I brought forth: While as yet he had not made the earth, nor the fields, nor the*

When he prepared the heavens, I was there: when he set a compass upon the face of the depth: When he established the clouds above: when he strengthened the fountains of the deep: When he gave to the sea his decree, that the waters should not pass his commandment: when he appointed the foundations of the earth: Then I was by him, as one brought up with him: and I was daily his delight, rejoicing always before him;***

Have you ever seen the Rockies, Smokies, or the Blue Ridge mountains? How about Victoria Falls, Iguazu Falls, Angel Falls or Niagara Falls? These and many others are great sights and wonders of the world. Have you ever walked the rivers of Mars or touched the rings of Saturn, or tasted the dirt on the Moon to make sure it was not cheese? God made all of these and so many more that we will only experience if we stay close to His side always.

Darwin wrote his book to get rid of the Bible. Mr. Darwin, when you get all the way back to the first two apes then what? What do you do when you get all the way back to the Big Bang? Or what do you do when you get all the way back to the chemical dust? or the premortal soup? Mr. Darwin where did it all come from? Genesis 1:1 ***In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.*** That is my Saviour, my God, my Comforter, that is my Redeemer, my friend and Wisdom.

Why in the world would you go to a chat group to find out how to live when you could go to God? He's seen it all. He's done it all except for sinning. He knows it all. The Bible says in Proverbs 8:32 ***Now therefore hearken unto me, O ye children: for blessed are they that keep my ways.***

When I was first saved, my friends called me weird. They told me I was going through a phase and that I would eventually come back to the real world. They called me a fanatic. They even tried to lure me back to their life. The hardest adjustment I had to make was losing some of my best friends who no longer wanted anything to do with me. But I tell you the truth, my life has been blessed so abundantly in so many ways that I could not have possibly accomplished on my own. I have more truer friends now than I ever could have in all parts of the world, and now, as I reach the end of my life, my only regret is that I should have trusted Christ as my Savior and lived by the Bible sooner.

It is just incredible what God has made available to us free of charge. Proverbs 8:34 ***Blessed is the man that heareth me, watching daily at my gates, waiting at the posts of my doors.***

The Lord has the wisdom necessary for you to make right choices. This wisdom can help you make choices that you will not regret years down the road. Take the time to search out wisdom. If you're going to make one friend

Proverbs 8:35-36 *For whoso findeth me findeth life, and shall obtain favour of the LORD. But he that sinneth against me wrongeth his own soul: all they that hate me love death.* People say, "I don't see it like that. If I sin, as long as it doesn't hurt anybody, it is alright." It hurts you; you just don't see it yet. "If I don't live by the Bible, I'm not harming anyone". You're harming yourself.

To think that the great God of glory would want to impart to us His wisdom is pretty amazing. If you picked a field of study, you would be really advantaged if you could go to the finest university and listen to the most expert lecturers in that topic. Or if you chose a branch of the armed services, you would greatly benefit being under the direction of the most expert military minds. If you want to be a musician, you would be so much better off taking lessons from a master musician. Well, we are not all going to have this career or join a branch of the service or pursue that field, but every one of us has a life to live, and how remarkable would it be if we could learn from the absolute Master of life. That is incredible! No tuition, no cost, just "Open the Bible"

What a good God we have. What an opportunity is ours to live with wisdom as our partner.
